

Instructions for Returning FACTS Users

Welcome Saint Paul Parents /Guardians:

If you are a returning family and are registering your child for the academic 2020-2021, please follow these steps:

- Visit <https://schools.worcesterdiocese.org/>
- Under “St. Paul Diocesan Jr.-Sr. High School” click on For More Information, Registration and Financial Aid Resources , scroll down and click on, “Enroll / Re-enroll with FACTS for Tuition Payment Plans and Financial Aid Application.”
- Sign-in using your current FACTS tuition payment agreement Username and Password.
- To complete the registration of your child, go to the left side of your FACTS Dashboard; please click on “Set up a Payment Plan”. Please follow all instructions provided to you to submit your tuition payment plan with FACTS. Once your tuition payment plan has been completed and submitted, your child will be officially enrolled as a student at Saint Paul Diocesan Jr.-Sr. High School.

Once you have completed your FACTS tuition payment plan, the Office of Student Accounts will enter the tuition rate, activity fee, and the \$195.00 non-refundable registration/processing fee and finalize your agreement on May 18, 2020. Once your agreement has been finalized by the Office of Student Accounts, you will receive a confirmation notice from FACTS via email correspondence regarding your tuition balance, payment date, and payment amount according to the plan you have chosen.

If you choose to apply for financial aid for the 2020-2021 academic year, please follow these steps:

- Under “FACTS Grant & Aid” click on “Start Application” on the right side of your FACTS Dashboard.
- Please follow all instructions provided to you by FACTS Grant & Aid to complete your application. Be sure to select the school name “Saint Paul Diocesan Jr. Sr. High School” under the student information section.
